

Public Hearing –Water Dept. Rules and Regulations

Supervisor opened public hearing at 5:45 p.m.

Clerk read notice into record.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Town Board of the Town of Lewiston, New York on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2011 beginning at 5:45 p.m., at the Town Hall, 1375 Ridge Road, to consider a local law amending Chapter 41 of the Town Code, entitled "APPENDIX – PART II WATER DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS" by amending §41-39, as follows:

- §41-39. Garden Service to be discontinued
1. Garden Service provided by the Town of Lewiston is hereby discontinued.
  2. Garden Service may continue for existing customers owning meters purchased from the Water Department at the time of the adoption of this provision which shall continue to be set and sealed in the spring and removed and read in the fall, by Water Department employees only.
  3. When removed, the consumption shown thereon shall be charged at the following rates:

- a. For those customers having had Garden Service established on or before December 31, 1999 the rates to be charged for Garden Service shall be the amount of water consumed by those customers at the regular rates charged for water pursuant to §41-43 hereof.

- b. For those customers having had Garden Service established on or after January 1, 2000 the rates to be charged for Garden Service shall be the amount of water consumed by those customers at the regular rates charged for water pursuant to §41-43 hereof, plus any charges based on water consumption pursuant to Chapter 21 of the Town Code regulating the use and maintenance of public sewers in the Town of Lewiston.

If adopted, this will become Local Law #1 – 2011

Supervisor asked residents for comments. No residents spoke.

Dowd recommended adoption of the Local Law.

**Winkley MOVED to close the Public Hearing. Seconded by Marra and Carried 3 – 0.** (5:50 p.m.)
